Data in the AWME database is made available in three types of Regime, assigned by the data owners

Is permission required to use the data from dataset owner?	Yes, for each dataset and terms of use must be negotiated for each dataset	No - dataset owner will be informed, but does not need to give specific permission for each dataset or set terms of use	No
Ownership of datasets in AWME	Remains property of dataset owner	Remains property of dataset owner	Remains property of dataset owner
Cost	Free	Free	Free
Authorship of publications and reports	Data applicant should negotiate joint authorship with dataset owner for each proposal	No requirement for joint authorship with dataset owner	No requirement for joint authorship with dataset owner
Can data be passed on to a third party or used for another purpose?	No	No	No
How long does the applicant have access to the dataset once it has been made available?	Three years	Three years	Three years

\*Other people who are not involved in AWME may ask for these data, but their request needs to be supported beforehand by one of the AWME dataset owners.
